Greetings from Bishopdale College Ma Ihowa koe e manaaki, mana koe e tiaki!

The LORD bless you and keep you!

'Sing to the LORD, bless His name; tell of His salvation from day-to-day. Declare His glory among the nations, His marvellous works among all peoples.'

Thank you for your concern for Bishopdale, and your partnership with us in our mission. I am pleased to update you at this stage of the year. The College is now in week 9 of our semester. It has been such a busy start to the year that we are only just surfacing from the deep dive of enrolments and beginning of the year administration. This year has been the most complicated we have ever had, and we have been working hard on getting all our students properly enrolled and organised.

A significant reason for this is the exciting progress we have made through our renewed partnership with Laidlaw College and our emerging partnerships in new settings. So, this year we have welcomed three students based with Holy Trinity Anglican in Tauranga, another in Taradale, two in Christchurch, and a bunch of part-time students in Wellington. This is on top of our students in Nelson, Golden Bay and Blenheim, as well as our two new students in Nelson from the Church of Confessing Anglicans. We are very excited about this, and very grateful to the Lord for giving us great people to work with – our greatest joy is always found in seeing students grow in depth of faith and the skills to live in

faithfulness to God's call. Our vision remains clear: to serve God by working in the Spirit to deeply disciple and equip the leaders God is raising up for the Church inside God's mission. Let me write something I often say: Jesus raised up leaders by first making disciples ... we need to do what He does. Looking ahead, we anticipate significant further growth into 2025. In many ways 2024 is a year of growth, but at the same time a year of preparation for further growth. A number of our partner settings are already working to raise up students for 2025 and we are encouraged by that! We have believed that doing a good job with the students God has given us would gradually lead to more settings valuing what we do and wanting to partner with us. We are seeing that happen.

Financially, as I wrote at Christmas, the College has been blessed with some new grant income for 2024-2028. This has allowed us to hire an extra person in administration – Natasha de Jong has joined us in a 0.8 role – and also bring existing staff up to more appropriate pay rates. As ever, the College is a ministry, not a business, and money will be tight, but we are blessed by the faithfulness of God and know that He will hold us.

Please continue to pray for the College and the staff and students. We especially ask for prayer that we would have wisdom to hear God's voice and follow God's lead, so that our students are blessed and God's work is advanced. May God's glory and goodness be revealed in what God does through us. Thank you for your support and enthusiasm for God's work through our College. Your financial support and your partnership in prayer is very important. May the Lord bless you.

WHERE ARE THEY NOW?

Renata van der Wal, Bishopdale alumni

I'm Renata van der Wal, Bishopdale Student from 2022-2023 (to graduate in two weeks!). I first heard about Bishopdale College from Bishop Steve at the beginning of 2021, when I was still living in Christchurch and was dead set against moving. Fast forward to 2022, and I found myself living in Nelson and doing a Level 6 Diploma of Christian Ministry at Bishopdale and interning as a worship intern at Victory Church, which I thought was going to be a one year study. Little did I know that God was planning for me to do Level 7 in 2023, and stay on at Victory as their Worship Coordinator. During this year, I also picked up a 10 hour a week job at the Anglican Centre working for the Nelson Anglican Diocese as their events coordinator alongside study. As of February 2024, my role has moved into a more permanent role as Ministry Education Project and Anglican Centre Administrator for 32 hours a week. As part of this role, I am involved in Ministry Education projects, such as the Diocesan Leadership Camp in July, and am also handling a lot of the admin for the Anglican Centre at reception.

Studying at Bishopdale helped me in preparing for this role, as it not only helped me to network and form relationships within the diocese, but also provided me with a solid theological basis and understanding of key topics that are discussed in the diocese. Studying at Bishopdale also helped me to not only know the theory of theology, but also to be able to use it practically and connect within my context. My time at Bishopdale College was a blessing to me and I have grown so much during my studies, both in my education and in my faith.

Greetings in the risen Lord Jesus! It has been a great joy to arrive in Nelson (from Christchurch) with my wife Amanda and one of our three sons (the other two staying in Christchurch for employment and tertiary study). After leading Anglican churches for eleven years in the Diocese of Christchurch and then for five years with the Church of Confession Anglicans, it's been a big change to move to Nelson and to start teaching at Bishopdale. We've come as part of the partner-ship between BTC and CCA, with two full-time BTh students also



making the move to Nelson. In the midst of all the change the Lord has been wonderfully faithful, and we've been warmly welcomed into the College and St Stephen's Tahunanui where we've settled, as well as by Bp Steve and Watiri. We are so thankful.

I'm excited to take part in how the Lord will use Bishopdale to equip men and women with a rich knowledge of the gospel, training them to proclaim Christ crucified and risen, calling all to repentance and faith in him. While Church History (and especially the history of the English reformation) is my area of focus, being able to help students wrestle with, and grow in their love and confidence in the Holy Scriptures, is a particular passion. I came to faith after being told by a minister that I couldn't trust what was in the Bible, and (being contrary in nature!), I went home and starting reading the Bible for myself. In those pages I read the voice of God, and was introduced to Jesus. By his word he did his work in my heart (as he continually promises to do). Please pray that our students would themselves listen to the voice of God in the Bible, and grow to love and adore him more and more. And pray that they might be so captured by this gospel word, that they might be compelled to give themselves to his service and glory.
